

**Michigan Grape and Wine Conference  
February 24–26, 2010 – Grand Rapids, Michigan**

**Wine for Welcome Reception (Feb. 24),  
Lunch (Feb. 25) and Grazing Dinner (Feb. 25)**

Please help provide wine for the Welcome Reception, Lunch and Grazing Dinner. If you'd like to contribute wine to be served at these events, here's the procedure (check exchange):

- Select three to six bottles you wish to have served (three to six bottles of one wine or single bottles - any way you choose). We suggest that wineries that produce more than 2,500 cases of wine per year bring six bottles, smaller wineries (<2,500 cases) bring three bottles.
- Generate an invoice to Amway Grand Plaza Hotel billed at your posted wholesale price. Address on the invoice should be: 187 Monroe St., Grand Rapids, MI 49503.
- **Fax an invoice by Wednesday, February 17, to the Council office at 517-335-0628 (no cover page needed).** We will gather all invoices and fax them all together to the Amway. You do not need to fax or mail your invoice to the Amway. **If we do not have your invoice by February 17, your wines cannot be served.**
- Make out a check in the same amount to "Lansing Area Safety Council" **(NOT WineMichigan)** who will pay the wine bill at the Amway. (The Lansing Area Safety Council is on contract with the Grape and Wine Council to manage the registration revenue and payment of some conference expenses.)
- Bring wine and check payable to Lansing Area Safety Council with you to the conference. When you arrive, conference registration staff outside the Vandenberg Room (MDA staff) will direct you to a location for delivery of wine and exchange of checks.
- A check to your winery from the Amway will be available during the conference.

**No wines** may be brought to events in conference meeting rooms at the Amway that have not been invoiced with an invoice received in the Council office by Feb 17.

Thanks for your support of the meeting. We look forward to enjoying many fine Michigan wines during the conference.
